

Our heartfelt appreciation goes out to everyone who supported the event in one way or other and made it a success.


















DSES ALUMNI LEAD THE WAY IN THE "EDUCATION TO INDUSTRY AND BEYOND" WEBINAR

They shared their experience in navigating studies and work in the sports, health and wellness industry with current SHL students and lecturers. A few alumni members who have made inroads into high performance sports and physiotherapy shared helpful tips about becoming established in these domains.

During the webinar, 2013 graduate and valedictorian Eric Li highlighted how the counsel from his DSES lecturer, Gideon Tan, was pivotal in his decision to pursue Physiotherapy for his university studies.
