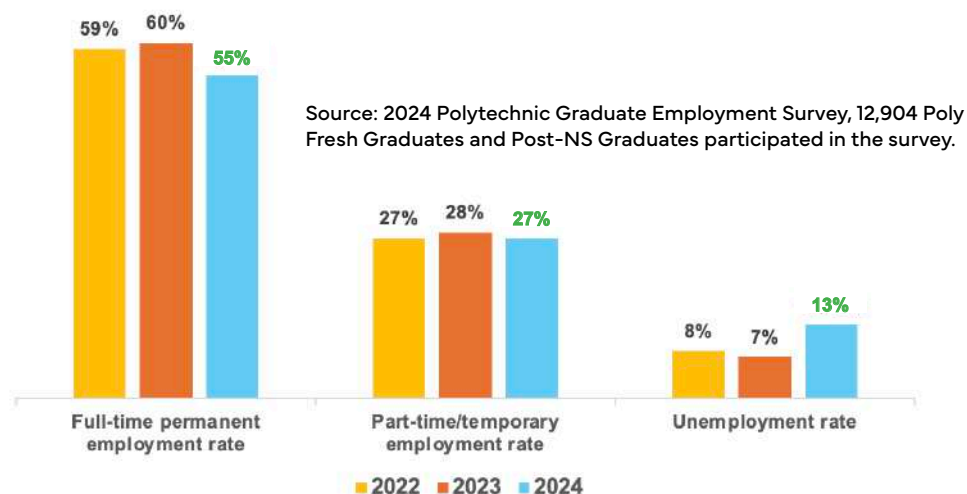
What can I learn from the Polytechnic Graduate Employment Survey (GES) to help me prepare for my job search

GES is an annual survey conducted by all five polytechnics for their graduates. Graduates who respond to this survey will help their juniors, industry, and themselves, understand the job market conditions better based on real data. Insights from Polytechnic Graduate Employment Survey 2024

- Fewer fresh polytechnic graduates landed full-time permanent jobs in 2024, although more of them received high salaries.
- Median gross monthly salary among graduates in full-time permanent employment increased from \$2,800 in 2023 to \$2,900 in 2024.
- 87.5% of polytechnic graduates in the labour force were employed within six months of graduation or after completing full-time National Service, against the backdrop of slower employment growth in 2024 as compared to 2023.

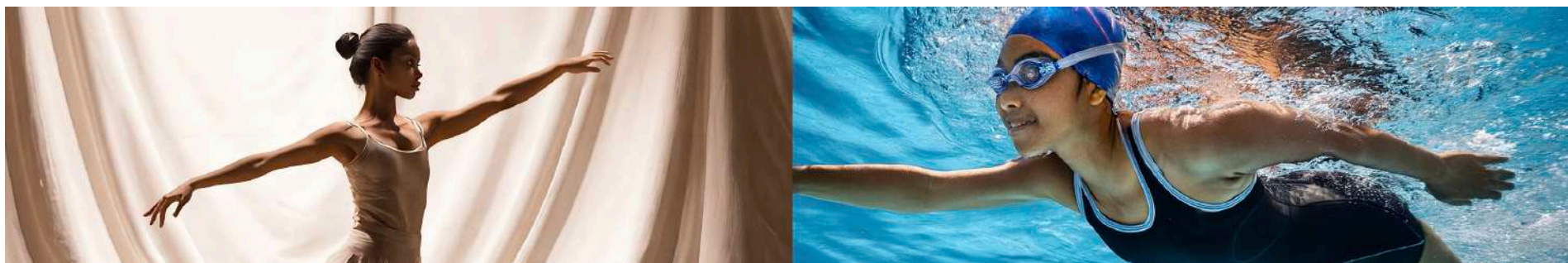
